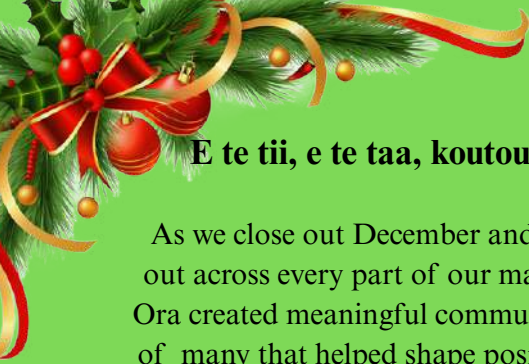

As we close out December and reflect on the year that has been, the strength of our collective effort stands out across every part of our mahi. Tuuhono focused on greater health outcomes in community and Te Puna Ora created meaningful community benefit through their networking and workshops naming just 2 outcomes of many that helped shape positive change for hapori and whānau. Through resilient partnerships grounded in shared values, we have protected what matters most to our people while creating opportunities for active participation across the community. These partnerships have enabled us to deliver services and solutions that are not only effective, but culturally anchored and community-led.

The impact of this work is being felt in tangible ways: families living in safer, warmer homes; improved access to and delivery of health services through the completion of TaiTimu Tai Pari - our new Health hub; Enterprise initiatives such as our gym Te Whare Oranga and our Taniwha cart providing affordable solutions to fitness and wellbeing. For Pou Ltd, intergenerational employment pathways that support both local leadership, rangatahi and kaumātua; and a strengthened food supply from our Maara Kaahui Tuuwaa has ensured our community is nourished and supported. Each outcome reflects our commitment to our vision and mission statements set 6 years ago. As we move into our year, we do so with confidence—knowing that when we work together, grounded in our values, we create lasting change for current and future generations.
